Monthly	Portfolio Review and Discussion	 Portfolio structure is dissected bond-by-bond Thorough discussion of the current market, current portfolio and performance Analysis includes a thorough review of the historical total return of the portfolio Recommendations provided based on portfolio findings and analysis
As Needed	Investment Offerings	 Detailed pre-purchase analysis of each bond being offered Inclusive of pertinent Bloomberg screenshots - better depicting bond characteristics Blomberg ALLQ /BVAL provided as a second pricing source
Time of Trade	Trade Tickets	 Provides immediate verification of trade / settlement date / and amount due at settlement Emailed same day trade is executed
Every Trade	Trade Packages	 Provides due diligence on every bond purchased Specifically includes - What the market looked like day-of-purchase / what was the Strategic Purpose of the purchase / confirmation that purchase is consistent with investment policy / and Bloomberg screenshots that better capture the analysis the client used in considering to make the purchase Assist in regulatory exam prep
Monthly	Pricing Report	 Detailed market value changes Quarterly market value shock reporting Includes prior months market value and month-over-month change Weighted Average Life (WAL) details / MBS/ CMO Info sheet
Monthly	Historical Total Return Report (HTR)	 Provides report card on Mortgage-Backed Securities and Amortizing Bonds Incorporated as part of the monthly investment discussion and analysis Better assesses the performance of each bond over a period-of-time Answers the question: <i>"Is the bond I purchased still doing the job I intended it to do"</i>
Monthly	Credit Surveillance	 Ratings for Credit Sensitive Bonds-utilizing both traditional and non-traditional credit rating agencies The "Rating Change Anticipator" offers a methodology to monitor anticipated ratings changes
Twice Per Month	Wire Summaries	 Detailed summary of all principal and interest (P&I) bond-by-bond Summary emailed each time a complimentary wire is sent, so each dollar is accounted for
Monthly	Bond Accounting	• Provided by a 3rd Party - use for month-end / board reports / and 5300 reporting
